



02 Important Notes

- a. Applicants must accurately select the academic unit(school or major) they wish to apply for.
 - ※ Once the application is submitted, it cannot be canceled, changed, or resubmitted due to errors such as failure to check the day/evening or other mistakes.
- b. The applicant's Alien Registration Number (or passport number) must be the same as the number on the official identification document (passport, Alien Registration Card etc.). If the number has been changed, supporting documents must be submitted.
- c. Only original documents are accepted (including documents issued through public institution fax services). However, for international applicants from countries affected by natural disaster or national crises (e.g., war), submission of required documents will be handled as follows:
 - ① Documents previously submitted for admission to this universities' Korean Language Program may be accepted in lieu of new submissions.
 - ② For documents previously submitted to other universities' Korean Language Programs, copies certified as "true to the original" will be accepted.
 - ③ In all other cases, original documents must be submitted.
 - ※ If faxed documents are unclear or illegible, resubmission will be required.
- d. Applicants must check the required documents for each admission track and submit them to the International Cooperation Center by the submission deadline. Failure to submit or submission after the deadline will result in disqualification.
- e. In the section titled "Account for Application Fee and Tuition Refund", applicants must enter and active bank account number under the applicant's or guardian's name. The applicants bears full responsibility for any disadvantages caused by incorrect account information.
- f. Contact Information such as mobile phone number and email address must be entered accurately so that the applicant or guardian can be promptly contacted during the admission process. Any disadvantages arising from missing or incorrect contact information are the responsibility of the applicant.
- g. Applicants must ensure that no errors, omissions typos, or missing required documents occur in their application.
- h. Additional documents may be requested during the review process to verify eligibility.

The university outsources the application process to an authorized application agency and does not use the collected personal information (name, alien registration number, phone number, email address, bank account number, etc.) for any purpose other than admissions.

III Eligibility and Required Documents

Eligibility Criteria

01 Nationality

- The applicant **and both parents must be non-Korean nationals**.
- Applicants holding **dual nationality (Korean + foreign)** or whose parents hold Korean nationality are **not eligible** to apply.

02 Academic Background(Eligibility)

[Undergraduate Admission] Graduates (or expected graduates by August 2026) of a regular high school in Korean or abroad.

[Transfer Admission] Graduates (or expected graduates by August 2026) from a college/university (associate degree or higher) in Korea or abroad, or those who have completed at least two academic years (minimum 65 credits) at a 4-year university.

- ※ 1.High School Equivalency Tests (GED), homeschooling, or online learning programs are not recognized as equivalent academic qualifications.
- 2. If the applicant and parents obtained foreign nationality before starting a program equivalent to a Korean high school, eligibility is recognized.

03 Language Proficiency Requirements

All language certificates must be valid as of the admission date

(1) Korean Language Requirements

Applicants must meet one of the following conditions.

1. TOPIK Level 3 or higher

- ▶ TOPIK Level 4 required for: School of law & business Administration (Business Administration Major)
- ▶ Conditional admission with Level 3 (plus 200-hour Korean course) for: School of Humanities and Public Leadership (English language & Culture Major)
- ▶ Applicants who took TOPIK (102nd or 103rd) may apply with an exam slip but must submit a valid Level 3 certificate before enrollment; failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

2. HKNU Korean Language Program completion

- ▶ Completion of **Level 4 or higher** (must be completed before the document submission deadline)

- ❑ **Even if Level 4 is already completed, the applicant must remain registered in the Korean Language Program until the final semester before admission (e.g., Summer term for September admission)**
- 3. **Korea Immigration and Immigration and Integration Program(KIIP)** Completion of **Level 3 or higher**, or pre-assesemtn score of 61 or higher.
- 4. **King Sejong Institute** Completion of **Intermediate Level 1 or higher**

(2) English Language Requirements (for English Track) 04

Applicants must meet one of the following standards:

1. IELTS 5.5 or higher
2. TOEFL PBT 530(CBT 197, iBT 71) or higher
3. CEFR B2 or higher
4. TEPS 601 points or higher (New TEPS 327+)

1) When the sponsor is the applicant or parent

- Minimum amount

- **HKNU Korean Language Program students: KRW 10,000,000 (≈USD 7,200)**
- **Other applicants: KRW 20,000,000 (≈USD 14,300)**

- Certificate must be issued within 30 days of submission and remain valid until after March 3, 2026.
- Applicants residing in Korea must submit a **Korean bank certificate** under their own name.

2) When the sponsor is not the applicant or parent (All four of the following documents are required)

- ① Bank balance certificate (same amount criteria as above)
- ② Employment certificate (or business registration)
- ③ Property tax or income certificate
- ④ Financial Certification Form (HKNU Form 3)

<Important Notes>

- a. All documents must be originals. If unavailable due to natural disasters or wartime conditions, alternative verification is possible.
 - ① Documents previously submitted for admission to HKNU Korean Language Program may be accepted in lieu of new submissions.
 - ② For documents previously submitted to another university's Korean Language Program, copies certified as "true to the original" will be accepted.
 - ③ In all other cases, submission of original documents is required.
- b. Academic credentials issued abroad must have an **Apostille or Consular Authentication**.
- c. Documents not in Korean or English must include a **notarized Korean or English translation**.
- d. All documents in the listed order.
- e. Applicants in Korea must submit entry/exit and alien registration certificates.
- f. HKNU Forms 2-4 must be completed and submitted by all international applicants

Interview Examination

1. Interview Date : **(1st Round)** June 15-June 19, 2026 **(2nd Round)** July 13-July 17, 2026
 ※ This schedule is subject to change.
2. Venue: To be announced on the HKNU International Cooperation Center(ICC) and Admissions Website.
3. Required Materials: Examination slip (printed from the application site) and valid identification (passport, alien registration card, driver's license, or temporary photo ID issued by a local government office).
4. Format: In-person or online interview.
 ※ online interviews available for applicants residing outside Korea.
5. Interview Guidelines
 - a. Applicants must arrive 20 minutes before the scheduled start time.
 - b. Identification verification is mandatory — failure to present a valid photo ID will result in disqualification.
 - c. Only IDs issued by authorized institutions with a photo, full name, and identification number (e.g., passport or alien registration number) will be accepted.
 - d. All eligible applicants (except those disqualified during document review) must attend the interview.
 - e. Further details will be announced via the HKNU ICC and Admissions websites.

IV Important Notes for Applicants

Please read carefully before applying.

01 Basic Rules

- a. Admission evaluation results and scoring details will **not be disclosed**.
- b. Once submitted, applications **cannot be cancelled, modified, or duplicated**.
- c. Submitted documents **will not be returned**.
- d. Applicants must bring their **examination slip and valid ID** to the interview.
- e. Expired IDs or IDs without a photo/name/registration number are **invalid**.
- f. Applicants failing to bring identification will be **disqualified**.
- g. Matters not specified in this guideline shall be governed by the **HKNU University Admission Fairness Committee** and relevant academic regulations.

02 Prohibited and Disqualifying Cases

- a. Dual registration at multiple universities is prohibited.
- b. Admission may be revoked or cancelled under any of the following:
 1. Failure to attend the interview.
 2. Failure to submit required documents within the deadline.
 3. Submission of forged or falsified documents, proxy testing, or any other form of misconduct.
 4. Violation of eligibility criteria after submission.

※ If any of the above disqualifying reasons are found after admission, enrollment will be invalidated.

03 Announcement of Successful Applicants

If admitted to another university, applicants must immediately inform HKNU of their decision to **withdraw enrollment** to prevent duplicate registration.

- b. Payment Method : Access the HKNU admission site, print the tuition invoice, and transfer payment to the designated virtual account listed on the invoice.
- c. Note
 - The virtual account is valid only during the registration period.
 - Failure to pay within the registration period will be considered a withdrawal of admission.
 - Applicants are responsible for any disadvantages caused by missed deadlines or incorrect payments.


